FOOD RECALL OF SWEET AND SALTY TRAIL MIX –BECAUSE OF POSSIBLE HEALTH RISK, DUE TO POTENTIAL PRESENCE OF *LISTERIA MONOCYTOGENES*. *Listeria monocytogenes*, an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Although, healthy individuals may suffer only short-term symptoms, such as high fever, severe headache, stiffness, nausea, abdominal pain and diarrhea. *Listeria* infection can cause miscarriages and stillbirths among pregnant women.

Rucker's Wholesale and Service Co. of Bridgeport, IL is voluntarily recalling the specific code dates listed below of Uncle Bucks Sweet & Salty Trail Mix peg bag, due to the potential presence of *Listeria monocytogenes*.

The affected product is packaged in a 3.oz, clear bag with Uncle Buck paper header card, UPC 752545073390. This only affects packages with best by codes 031417 & 041817. The recall of Uncle Bucks Sweet & Salty Trail Mix is distributed nationwide in Bass Pro Shops stores.



Please note, no illnesses reported to date.

Rucker's learned about the problem after being notified by our supplier that sunflower kernels used in the Sweet & Salty Trail Mix were recalled for potential presence of *Listeria monocytogenes*.

Food Recall Warning

Uncle Buck's brand Sweet & Salty Trail Mix recalled due to *Listeria monocytogenes*

OTTAWA, May 11, 2016 – Rucker's Wholesale and Service Co. is recalling Uncle Buck's brand Sweet & Salty Trail Mix from the marketplace due to possible *Listeria monocytogenes* contamination. Consumers should not consume the recalled product described below.

What you should do

If you think you became sick from eating a recalled product, call your doctor.

Food contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes* may not look or smell spoiled but can still make you sick. Symptoms can include vomiting, nausea, persistent fever, muscle aches, severe headache and neck stiffness. Pregnant women, the elderly and people with weakened immune systems are particularly at risk. Although infected pregnant women may experience only mild, flu-like symptoms, the infection can lead to premature delivery, infection of the newborn or even stillbirth. In severe cases of illness, people may die.
